Six More Labor Organizations Endorse Assemblymember Betsy Butler for Re-election

The campaign to re-elect Assemblymember Betsy Butler to the California State Assembly announced endorsements from six more labor organizations. Endorsements for Assemblymember Butler's re-election to Assembly District 50 were received from the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 11, Ironworkers Local 433, The National Association of Letter Carriers, AFL-CIO, and the United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW) Locals 324, 770 and 1428.

"Butler is a champion for working families," said Rick Icaza, President of UFCW Local 770. "Strong leadership is essential to ensuring that workers get a fair deal in these troubled economic times, and we trust Betsy Butler to provide that leadership."

"I am proud to receive support from of the many labor organizations that have engaged in my re-election campaign," said Butler. "I look forward to continuing my work in the Legislature to advocate for working families and promote California job creation."

IBEW Local 11 represents over 7,500 electrical workers in Los Angeles; Ironworkers Local 433 represents 5,000 ironworkers in Los Angeles. The National Association of Letter Carriers has nearly 300,000 members nationwide, primarily working as delivery carriers; UFCW Locals 324, 770 and 1428 represent thousands of retail workers in Southern California who work primarily in grocery stores and pharmacies.

Assemblymember Betsy Butler was elected to the California State Assembly in 2010 and is seeking re-election in the 50th Assembly District. Butler's work has focused on fighting for consumers, advocating for working families and protecting the environment. In the State Assembly, she serves on the Assembly Budget Committee, the Budget Sub-Committee on Resources and Transportation, the Committees on Business and Professions; Education; Arts, Entertainment, Sports, Tourism and Internet Media; and Rules.
