Assemblymember Betsy Butler Wins Endorsement of Local Democratic Delegates

Receives majority of endorsement votes

Assemblymember Betsy Butler received the endorsement from a majority of local democrats at the California Democratic Party's pre-endorsement conference. All those casting endorsement ballots are residents of the 50th Assembly District and delegates of the California Democratic Party and local Democratic clubs. Assemblymember Butler received 57.6% of the votes from residents from all over the district.
