### **Assemblymember Betsy Butler Wins Endorsement of Cesar Chavez' United Farm Workers**

Today, Arturo Rodriguez, President of the United Farm Workers, made public the following statement: "Too many politicians are afraid of the rich and powerful. Assemblymember Betsy Butler is our champion. Time after time, from the Dream Act to the organizing rights of farm workers, Betsy has stood strong for all that Cesar Chavez fought for. Betsy has won our hearts and earned our support. The United Farm Workers is proud to join Equality California, the California League of Conservation Voters and the Consumer Federation of California in supporting the re-election of Betsy Butler to the Assembly."

Assemblymember Butler calls the endorsement an "affirmation of my lifelong commitment to support farm workers, end discrimination and achieve a more equitable society."

Assemblymember Butler was elected to the Assembly a year ago after overcoming one of the largest special interest assaults on any new candidate in California history. Since her election, Butler received national attention for her success fighting the chemical and plastics lobby and winning an historic ban of BPA in baby bottles.

Butler's work has focused on fighting for consumers, advocating for working families and protecting the environment. In the State Assembly, she serves on the Assembly Budget Committee, the Budget Sub-Committee on Resources and Transportation, the Committees on Business and Professions; Education; Arts, Entertainment, Sports, Tourism and Internet Media; and Rules
